As this school year draws to a close, we are making plans for the arrival of our Class of 2025 at Wyomissing Area Jr/Sr High School in the fall. In an effort to provide a more personalized orientation experience for our upcoming 7th grade students, we have established two different dates this summer for them to go on a guided tour of the building. These small-group tours will be led by high school Student Council students and will last approximately 60-90 minutes. On the tour dates listed below, students will be given tentative copies of their class schedules, their locker assignments, a tour of the building, opportunities to ask questions, and time to independently walk through their schedules and try opening and closing their lockers.

Students are strongly encouraged to attend <u>one</u> of these small-group tours to increase their level of comfort and familiarity with the building. Parents are welcome to attend as well. Students should use the West Entrance off of Cambridge Avenue (Door # 1), and the tours will begin in the auditorium. It is very important that each family decide which tour date and time they will attend. Please call (610) 374-0739 (ext. 2132) in advance to register for the tour of your choice. Your call will ensure that we have your child's schedule and locker assignment ready upon arrival.

Also, we are offering students an optional On-Your-Own Visitation Day on Friday, August 16<sup>th</sup> from 8 AM to 2 PM. This day is not in lieu of the scheduled tours listed above; it is simply an additional opportunity for students to increase their familiarity with the building prior to the start of the school year. On this day, students are welcome to walk through their class schedules and practice using their lockers. No preregistration is necessary, and there will be no formal assistance available to students on this day. This is the only day students will be able to visit the building without being part of an organized tour this summer.

Please consider signing your student up for one of the Gear Up for 7th Grade sessions if they would like to have a more in-depth introduction to the Jr/Sr High School. Information about these sessions can be found in WASD's 2019 Summer Enrichment Camp packet on the District's homepage.

Finally, there will be an optional **7<sup>th</sup> Grade Parent Meeting** on Thursday, August 15<sup>th</sup> at 6 PM in the JSHS Auditorium. We will provide information about student agendas, materials needed for school, the school absence and discipline policies, lunch accounts, eSchoolBook, athletics, etc. This meeting is intended specifically for parents only, and there will not be an opportunity for building tours at this time.
