3. What do you see as the **central conflict** in the novel? What kind of **conflict** is it (ie. person vs. nature, person vs. person, person vs. society, etc.)? Why did you select this as the central conflict? How does tension build leading to this conflict? How is it finally resolved?

6. Discuss how the **process of reading** this novel has been for you. Was it easy or hard to read? Did you read it in June and then skim it again before completing this? Be specific and thorough. Be sure to fill at least five lines. Discuss any successes or frustrations you felt as you read.
